### A Quick Interlibrary Loan Tutorial:

#### There are three different parts to Interlibrary Loan:

- Borrowing: What is borrowed from another library.
  - The overall health of our collection in specific subject areas.
  - Gaps where our coverage is lacking.
- <u>Lending</u>: What is lent to another library.
- <u>Document Delivery</u>: What is scanned for our own patrons.
  - Justifications for backfile journal purchases.

#### What reports to run in ILLiad for Borrowing, Lending, and DocDel

- Most Requested Journals and Most Requested Loans.
- Requests Finished and Cancelled, or Requests Filled or Unfilled
- Journals Received.
- Most Loaned Journals, and Most Loaned Loans

# Leveraging Interlibrary Loan Data for Journal Package Negotiations

- More granular journal usage by distinguishing between ILL lending and local access
- Ability to calculate costs for ILL it determine if cheaper than subscription costs.
  - Copyright by publisher varies greatly! Ask your ILL librarian to calculate the average cost they pay.
    - For example, at KState we pay about \$25 per article for Elsevier however, Taylor & Francis can be \$75 or more for one article.

## UnSub for Breaking Deals

- Evaluates big packages for renewal or cancelation:
  - Shows perpetual post- termination access beyond yearly subscriptions.
  - Provides a list of titles that have turned OA and can be accessed online for free.
  - It calculates a cost per use based on data imported.
    - Note on Elsevier: for R1s Elsevier does not provide an accurate costs list. They refer to the published list on their website which is created for smaller institutions. R1s pay based on usage, and Elsevier does not share how it calculates cost. (i.e. pay more for what is most used.)



## Using UnSub:

#### Title-by-title subscription

39.6%

This is the percentage of usage that can't be fulfilled by any free source, but can be fulfilled by one of your title-bytitle subscriptions.

#### **Post-Termination Access**

52.7%

This is the percentage of usage that can't be fulfilled by Open Access, but can be fulfilled under your PTA rights.

#### Open access

  - End product will calculate a true cost per student savings


