





## Student Behavior with Course Resources

#### Student Response:

- Found an alarming 63% just start googling
- Found 47% of students find resources for assignments and studies from their course page on the LMS, course reading list or what their instructor shares
- Demonstrates importance of the library's discovery presence in the LMS and course reading lists to meet students where they are and provide greater support



# ...but patrons want the library more deeply embedded in their workflows

Responses to the Question:

Would patrons and librarians adopt a comprehensive digital application of their library?

Contrary to any notions that patrons 'just want to be left alone', 88% of patrons want the library more deeply embedded in their workflow

# THE COURSE RESERVES PROBLEM AT HSC

2019- Library Staff embed links directly into Canvas shells. Course reserves is a shelving location and textbook-specific.

**2020**- COVID-19. No print access available. Library migrates to WMS and begins to use that course reserves module

2021- 3 Trained library staff members & 3 active course reserves

- Limited to items in WorldCat unless a temporary record was created
- No organization of resources possible
- Did not integrate into Canvas
- No copyright module for outside or faculty owned materials
- No faculty buy in across campus
